Essential pavement work will be carried out on Kintore Street, Dulwich Hill, from McArthur parade to Cul de Sac.

What work are we doing?

The work includes asphalting Kintore Street Dulwich Hill to provide an improved road surface between Fredrick Street & Alt Street which includes Heavy patching.

When we'll be working

Work will be carried out from **Wednesday 5th of June until 6th of June**, weather permitting.

Work hours are between 7:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Friday (Saturday if required 8am – 4pm).

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Access to residents' properties will be maintained throughout the work, and motorists are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers.

The section of road undergoing resurfacing will need to be cleared of vehicles from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the day of the work. Please find alternative parking during this time.
