Hammond Park upgrade construction notification

Council is installing new fencing and sandstone blocks at Hammond Park. The works include:

- Removal and disposal of all wooden barriers.
- Installation of 1m high black chain mesh fencing along Frederick Street. The entrance will consist of an opening with a setback fence 1.5 m away from footpath and a concrete pad.
- Installation of 1m high black chain mesh fencing along Henry Street adjoining the existing galvanised metal fencing.
- Installation of sandstone blocks along Lucy Street and turning into Henry Street.

Timing

The works are scheduled to start in mid-January 2022 and expected to be completed by March 2022.
