E-Waste - Important Message



Separate whitegoods, metals. garden waste and mattresses into different piles. These materials may be collected a few days after other materials, as they are recycled



Bundle and tie garden material with string. Branches and stems must be less than 1m in length and no thicker than 100mm



Remove all doors and locks from refrigerators and items that have compartments



Place less than 3 cubic metres per household out for collection



Place all items out for collection on the kerbside on Sunday 20 May 2018

ON'T...



Don't put out materials that are dangerous or too large



Don't put out commercial or building waste for collection



Don't place materials so that they block the footpath or hinder pedestrian access



Don't place materials out late they will not be collected



Don't place items into plastic bags

COLLECTED





Furniture that can easily be picked up by one person



Broken household items



Bundled and tied rope, cable, string and hose



Mattresses. cushions and pillows



Whitegoods eg. fridge, stove, washing machine



Plant cuttings must be tied in bundles with string. Branches less than 1m in length and stems no thicker than 100mm

NOT COLLECTED





Dangerous/hazardous material, glass and medical waste



Liquid waste eg. paint, chemicals, oils



Garden waste not tied and bundled with string. **NO** soil, tree stumps, treated wood, stones



concrete, bricks, tiles, waste or items placed fence palings and rails



Building materials eg. No food waste, general into plastic bags



Motor vehicle parts, oil, batteries, tyres



Why do I need to place some materials separately?
