## NO PARKING

Fine:
What does it mean? You may only park for two minutes to drop off or pick up children, and you have to stay withing 3 m of your vehicle. If no spaces are available, drive around the block and only return when there is a space.

Why is it there? To provide a safe place for children to be set down and picked up without endangering others.

## BUS ZONE

What does it mean? You must not stop your vehicle in the bus zone for any reason (including queuing and waiting for a space) unless you are driving a

Why is it there? To provide a safe place for large buses to set down and pick up school children.

## PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

What does it mean? Keep an area of 20 m before and 10 m after a pedestrian crossing clear. Do not let your child in or out of a vehicle at a pedestrian crossing.

Why is it there? To ensure children can be clearly seen by vehicles approaching the crossing.


## DOUBLE PARKING

What does it mean? You must not stop your vehicle, and or park in the middle of the road to drop off and pick up.

Demerit
points: 2

Why is it there? Double parking forces cars to go around you causing traffic congestion. It also reduces the view of drivers and children crossing the road.

## DRIVEWAYS AND FOOTPATHS

What does it mean? Do not park your vehicle on or across a driveway.
Why is it there? To ensure that you don't force pedestrians onto the road to get around you.
