Sydney's inner west has a thriving creative and independent art scene – influenced by a rich industrial and multicultural history and an inclusive and progressive community.

Home to one of Australia's most impressive collections of street art, the inner west is an inspiring mix of history, creativity and culture - and Perfect Match is a 'perfect' opportunity to meet the creatives and discover the outdoor galleries and fascinating urban canvasses.

Perfect Match is a unique Council initiative tackling unwanted graffiti by fostering legitimate creative expression and art. Property owners are invited to find their Perfect Match by nominating their wall to be transformed by an artist. Artists submit their designs and ideas for public art. And Council then plays cupid.

Join in the fun! From 4 to 6 August 2017, we'll celebrate not only the 16 new works created through Perfect Match 2017, but also some of the best existing street artworks across our vibrant inner west.

On Friday 4 August, join a special guided tour to explore the Wall2Wall program. a collection of artworks created over ten

years across Leichhardt, Balmain, Lilyfield, Annandale and Camperdown.

Then on Saturday 5 August, join community celebrations and meet Alex Lehours as he applies finishing touches to his new work inspired by the historic Vicar's Woollen Mill in Marrickville. Enjoy an artist talk at Enmore Park and then hop on a free "whistle stop" train tour to experience street art and culture at communities along the line from Newtown to Ashfield.

And on Sunday 6 August, Sydenham is the focus. Take a guided tour and discover art laden laneways and innovative creative industries amidst the gritty industrial landscape.
