Desirable Planning Objectives: Institute a planned long-term scheme for improving the area including the plaza, the surrounding surfaces and streets, the carpark itself and the adjacent buildings, some of which present only back yards and service areas to the public space. Effective improvements to the plaza such as landscaping and street furniture are possible only within the context of such a big term scheme.

Additional Comments: It would be desirable, when work is carried out on the plaza area, to re-instate the adjacent kerbline in its original alignment matching the rest of the western kerb of Lackey Street.
