Description: A two-storey building of brick and painted stucco. The ground floor shopfront, though altered, probably had a similar arrangement of central ingo, splayed windows, stallboards and top hampers. The upper storey has a three-light window with a segmentally arched head and the parapet above is marked by moulded string courses and thin vertical ribs capped above the coping line, between which are roughcast panels.

Modifications: The present facade is less than one third of its original length, the frontage having originally extended much further westwards towards Dalhousie Street. It also had a substantial double-storeyed verandah with paired turned timber posts, exposed upper floor beams, elaborate brackets to the lower storey posts and, at the upper level, a delicate frieze screen of turned and square timber members. The present footpath awning is a suspended steel structure. Details of the original shopfront are not known.




