Improving the Footpath in Marion Street, Leichhardt

Council is proposing to upgrade the existing footpath in Marion Street, Leichhardt (from the frontages of the properties of 145A to 159 Marion Street – North side only meaning opposite side of the Leichhardt Marketplace) by replacing the existing concrete footpath with new decorative concrete pavers.

The Plan

The proposed footpath upgrade work is summarised below and are illustrated on the attached Consultation Plan (Plan No. 10188):

Marion Street-North side only; the properties frontages (145A to 159 Marion St):

- Remove existing concrete footpath and provide new decorative concrete pavers laid with a border and infill paving pattern. New decorative pavers will match with existing Town centre pavers used in Marion Street, i.e.,
 - Infill pavers – grey colour and 400x400x40mm sizes,
 - Border pavers – sandstone in colour and 400x400x40mm sizes,
- Replace all existing service pit covers with new decorative paver infilled pit covers (where possible);
- Provide new Stainless Steel Tactile Indicators for kerb ramp to improve pedestrian safety.

Generally:

- Replace any damaged sections of gutter and kerb as required within the scope of works area
- Replace any stormwater outlet pipes which run under the footpath (between the building line and kerb only) with new pipes, where required.

For more details, please refer to the enclosed plans which highlight the proposed scope of works to be undertaken.

Parking changes:

This proposed streetscape works does not propose to change existing on street parking arrangements and therefore there will be no loss of parking spaces.
