- ③ Refresh existing E1 edge line on road-side of cycleway
- (4) Repaint C4 bicycle path centre line on cycleway
- (5) Install a regulatory pavement marking group consisting of a path arrow + cyclist symbol +"ONLY" elongated lettering at all entry points to the cycleway to replace existing signs.
- (6) Install new TB-1 Give Way transverse lines on approaches to bicycle priority crossing as shown.
- 7 Adjust all service covers and surrounds where the drop/ridge exceeds 10mm.
- 8 Improve friction at all steel utility covers in accordance with TfNSW QA Specification-3360 for skid resistance coatings and the related Australian Standards.
- 9 Reduce kerb lips to less than 10mm at all driveways adjoining the cycleway along Carrington Read.
