Line Marking Works Cycleway Upgrade - Carrington Rd, Marrickville

Dear Residents and Businesses,

Inner West Council will soon be investing \$55,000 to upgrade the Carrington Road Cycleway at Intersections of Harriet Street, Schwebel Street, Ruby Street, Warren Street and Renwick Street, Marrickville.

The project involves:

- Installation of green painting at Intersections of Harriet Street, Schwebel Street, Ruby Street, Warren Street and Renwick Street, Marrickville, to provide continuity access and priority to cyclist at the intersections.
- Installation of the relevant signs and line markings.

Timing of work

The works will commence the week of Monday 8 April 2024 and take approximately one week to complete (weather permitting).

There will be daytime and nighttime works,

- Day time work from Monday to Tuesday (8-9 April 2024) from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- Nighttime work from Wednesday to Friday (10-12 April 2024) from 7:00 pm - 5:00 am.

There will be minimum noise during these hours.

Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic, pedestrian and cyclists flow around the site.

Access to properties and commercial premises will be maintained, however please note that some of the car parking spaces near the works will be closed to the public during construction. Please avoid parking next to or near the works in progress.


