The Terrace, Birchgrove – Kerb Extension

Dear Resident

Inner West Council will soon be improving the streetscape in The Terrace at the intersection with Ferdinand Street, Birchgrove by constructing a new sandstone edged landscaped garden bed in place of the existing bollards and rumble bars.

Timing of work

The works will commence on Monday 6 November 2023 and take approximately one week to complete (weather permitting).

Reducing construction impacts

The Terrace will be closed to traffic between 7am and 5pm Monday 6 November to Friday 10 November, weather permitting.

Traffic needing to access Grove St from Ferdinand St will be detoured via Rose St. Traffic control will be available to provide resident access to properties on The Terrace via the Grove St end of The Terrace.

Traffic Control will be used to maintain pedestrian flow around the site.

Please do not park next to or near the works in progress.
