## Gow Street at Fitzroy Ave and Punch St, Birchgrove – Kerb Extension

Dear Resident

Inner West Council will soon be improving pedestrian safety by constructing a new landscaped kerb extension in Punch Street & Gow Street to allow a new footpath to be constructed in Punch Street & Fitzroy Avenue, Birchgrove.

The project involves construction of new footpath on the northern side of Punch St between Gow St and Fitzroy Ave, reconstruction of the footpath and installation of new grass verge in Punch St opposite Gow St, and asphalt re-sheet of the intersection.

## Timing of work

The works will commence on **Tuesday 30 January 2024** and take approximately three weeks to complete (weather permitting).

## Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow around the site.

Access to properties will be maintained, however during construction, please do not park next to or near the works in progress.
