Beaman Park Bridge across the Cooks River Retrofitting of Stairs

Notification of Works

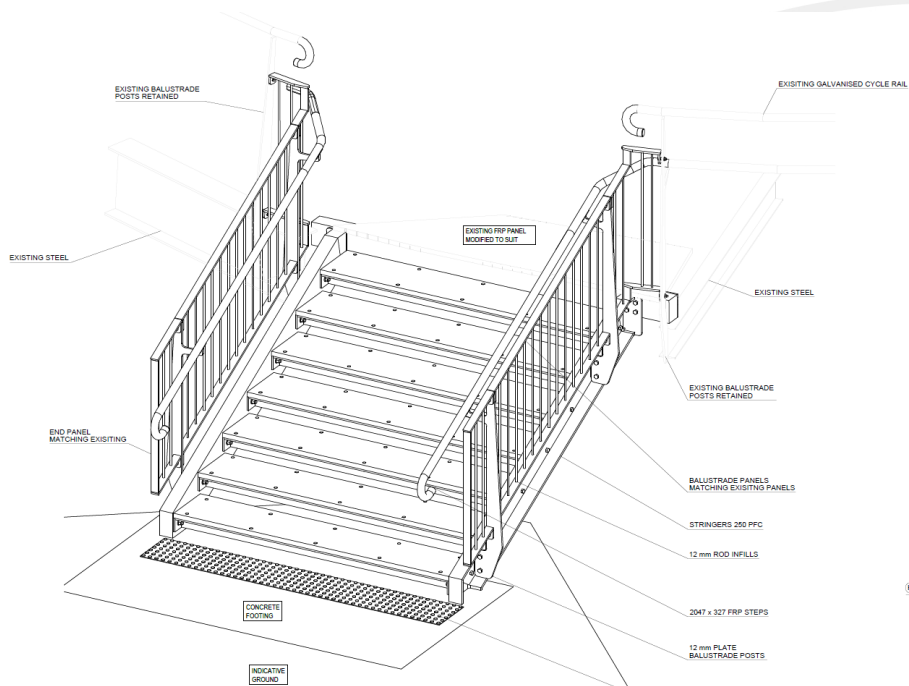
Inner West Council will soon be investing \$80,000 to improve pedestrian access between Beaman Park bridge and the southeastern bank of the Cooks River by installing stairs at the eastern end of the bridge in the position shown below.

The current arrangement requires pedestrians to leave the bridge in a northerly direction via the existing ramp and then find their way alongside or across the adjacent golf tee and fairway to access the southeastern bank of the river. The stairs will enable pedestrians to access the southeastern bank of the Cooks River directly from the bridge.

To accommodate the proposed stairs three existing trees require removal –

- 1 x She Oak,
- 1x Bottlebrush, and
- 1x Wattle tree (that is already dead)





Timing of the work

These works are planned to commence mid-June 2024, with expected completion of 30 June 2024, weather permitting. Pedestrian access across the bridge will be maintained during the works.
