Hardie Ave, Summer Hill – Raised Pedestrian Crossing

Dear Residents and Businesses,

Inner West Council will soon be investing \$126,000 to upgrade the pedestrian crossing in Hardie Ave, Summer Hill between the Council carpark and the entrance to Romeo's Mall.

The project involves:

- Construction of a new raised concrete pedestrian crossing together with new landscaped garden beds to replace the existing at-grade pedestrian crossing at the same location,
- Construction of a new raised concrete footpath across two (2) existing angle parking aisles to transition back down to road level,
- Relocation of the existing trolley bays and the existing Disabled Parking Spaces.

Timing of work

The works will commence the week of Tuesday 2 April 2024 and take approximately three weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow around the site.

Access to properties and commercial premises will be maintained, however please note that some of the car parking spaces near to the works will be closed to the public during construction. Please avoid parking park next to or near the works in progress.




