Peace Reserve, Newtown – Upgrade

Dear Residents and Businesses,

Inner West Council will soon be investing \$434,670 to upgrade Peace Reserve, Newtown.

The project involves:

- Removal of some trees and relaying of existing decorative pavers
- Refurbishment of the existing soft landscaping and garden beds
- Construction of new gravel pathways
- Supply and installation of new seating and decking
- Supply and installation of new irrigation and a new water bubbler
- Upgrade of the site drainage system

Timing of work

The works will commence the week of Monday 2 September 2024 and take approximately eight weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow around the site.

Access to properties and commercial premises will be maintained, however please note that some of the car parking spaces near to the works will be closed to the public during construction. Please avoid parking park next to or near the works in progress.


