Traffic Signal Upgrade – Edgeware Road (@ Llewellyn St & Alice St), Enmore

Dear Residents,

Inner West Council will soon be investing \$374,280 to upgrade existing traffic signal and overall condition of the intersection. Timing of work

The works will commence the week of Monday 20 May 2024 and take approximately two weeks to complete (weather permitting).

There will be daytime and nighttime works.

- Day time work from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- Nighttime work from 7:00 pm – 5:00 am.

There will be minimum noise during these hours.

Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrians flow around the site.

Access to properties and shops will be maintained, however please note that some of the car parking spaces near the works will be closed to the public during construction. Please avoid parking next to or near the works in progress.


