Upcoming Traffic Calming Works – Norton St Ashfield, Ashfield

Dear Resident,

Inner West Council will soon be investing \$390,000 to improve pedestrian safety, implement traffic calming and upgrade stormwater conditions along Norton Street, Ashfield.

Timing of work

The works will be carried out in separate stages commencing mid-February 2026 at the following Norton Street intersections:

- Carlisle Street – kerb extensions, raised traffic threshold, traffic islands and improved pedestrian access;
- Miller Avenue – kerb extensions and stormwater improvements;
- Hugh Street and Knox Avenue – kerb extensions, raised pedestrian crossing and pedestrian island;
- Holden Street to Knox Avenue – raised traffic threshold, traffic islands, road resheeting and line marking.

A separate notification letter will be sent out closer to the start of each stage of intersection works. The schedule is expected to take approximately 12 weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Reducing construction impacts

Access to properties will be maintained, however during construction, please do not park next to or near the works in progress. Some street parking will be used for work equipment and material storage.

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow around the site. Temporary detours may be used for short durations; however local traffic will always be maintained.
