Essential pavement work will be carried out on **Numa Street, Birchgrove from Louisa Road to dead End** which will include heavy patching.

What work are we doing?

The work includes asphaltting Numa Street to provide an improved road surface between Louisa Road to dead end.

When we'll be working

Work will be carried out from **Thursday 13th of June until Friday 14th of June**, weather permitting.

Work hours are between **7:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Friday** (Saturday if required 8am – 4pm).

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Access to residents' properties will be maintained throughout the work, and motorists are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers.

The section of road undergoing resurfacing will need to be cleared of vehicles from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the day of the work. Please find alternative parking during this time.
