


Urban Grove & Shelter

- A simple grove of deciduous and indigenous shade trees in large planting pods, defining an uncluttered central space and café seating areas at the edges.
- All planting pods with seating and possible perforated edges to collect rainwater run-off.
- Mature feature trees mark the northern and southern entries into the plaza
- New paving throughout in one alignment throughout the plaza to visually unify the ground plane
- A large shelter defines the southern edge of the plaza, provides shaded seating in summer while allowing sun penetration in winter and provides a possible venue for performances
- Lighting upgrade.

Paving Pattern



Large 900x300 Bluestone pavers - Uniform colour- sawn&honed and bushhammer or flamed finish-Vertical (stretcher bond) alignment Directional strips - 150mm wide- 400 x150mm pavers in granite or lighter coloured bluestone
