
Concept plan for new multi-purpose courts and facilities at Richard Murden Reserve, Haberfield





Phase 1 Works - Construction 2019

- Conversion of existing basketball court to three multi-purpose courts with reversible netball / basketball goals
- New bike racks and bins
- New planting and landscaping
- New water refill/dog bowl station
- Realign shared path (temporary path) adjacent to Hawthorne Canal
- Removal of existing path next to road
- New fencing between edge of courts and new shared path
- Removal of one fitness station
- New trees



Future Works - Funded

- 2020; New shared path and lighting as part of the GreenWay Master Plan works
- 2022; New public toilet

Future Works - Unfunded

- New picnic shelter and basketball half court
- New fitness station as part of Greenway Master Plan works

Improving Parking

- Existing parking spaces along Hawthorne Parade will be lined marked to improve parking efficiency
- Parking and traffic conditions will be reviwed six months after the courts are opened for use

Access to Courts

 The facilities will be hard surface training courts with bookings available during week day afternoons and evenings
