Inner West Council will soon be renewing the footpath in Harrison Street, Marrickville.

Providing high quality footpaths, kerbs and gutters and traffic infrastructure is a key priority. Council is maintaining community assets to protect safety and accessibility for all and ensure the cost to ratepayers of any repair works is minimised through ongoing maintenance.

These works are part of the \$33.2m investment Council has allocated to local roads, footpaths, traffic facilities, town centres, stormwater, car parks, town centres and cycleway upgrades this financial year.

Project features -

Capital Footpath Renewal and addition of a verge area.

Harrison Street, Marrickville - North side: remove existing asphalt footpath and construct a new 2m wide concrete footpath (or min. 1.5m where tree roots or other constraints may exist) and the addition of a 1.5m grass verge. Any existing maintained verge gardens will remain wherever possible.

Timings and work hours

The works will commence on Tuesday 22 November 2022 and take approximately one (2) weeks to complete (weather permitting).

The works will take place between 7am and 3 pm, Monday to Friday (Saturday if required)

Reducing construction impacts

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works. During construction, please do not park next to or near the works in progress.
