Signalised Pedestrian Crossing – Unwins Bridge Road (Tilman Park), Tempe

Dear Resident,

Inner West Council will soon be replacing the existing pedestrian crossing with a signalised crossing at Unwins Bridge Road (opposite Tilman Park), Tempe, to improve public safety in the area.

Providing high quality footpaths, kerbs and gutters and traffic infrastructure is a key priority. Council is maintaining community assets to protect safety and accessibility for all and ensure the cost to ratepayers of any repair works is minimised through ongoing maintenance.

Council is investing approximately \$250, 000 to bring you this project.

These works are part of the \$33.2m investment Council has allocated to local roads, footpaths, traffic facilities, town centres, stormwater, car parks, town centres and cycleway upgrades this financial year.
