Raised pedestrian crossings - Lords Road and Flood Street, Leichhardt

Dear resident,

Inner West Council will soon be upgrading the two pedestrian crossings at the intersection of Lords Road and Flood Street, Leichhardt.

Providing high quality footpaths, kerbs and gutters and traffic infrastructure is a key priority. Council is maintaining community assets to protect safety and accessibility for all and ensure the cost to ratepayers of any repair works is minimised through ongoing maintenance.

Council is investing approximately \$160,000 to bring you this project.

These works are part of the \$46.5m investment Council has allocated to local roads, footpaths, traffic facilities, town centres, stormwater, car parks, town centres and cycleway upgrades this financial year.

- Two new raised concrete pedestrian crossings and associated garden beds
- New concrete footpath, kerb and gutter between Myrtle Lane and 63 Flood Street

Timing of work

The works will commence the week of 30 May 2022 and take approximately four weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow around the site.

During construction, please do not park next to or near the works in progress.

Access to properties will be maintained, however there may be some temporary restrictions required at some stages of the works. Further notifications will be provided if access to your property will be impacted.
