Notice Of Planned <u>NIGHT WORKS</u> for Road Concrete Slab Replacement, Leichhardt

Norton Street, between Parramatta Road and Allen Street commencing Monday night 23 January 2023 Marion Street, between Balmain Road and Renwick Street commencing Monday night 30 January 2023

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

Inner West Council will soon be replacing concrete road slabs in the above locations.

Due to high day time traffic volumes in these locations, Transport for NSW only permits works to be undertaken **during night time hours between 7:30pm and 5:00am**.

Providing high quality footpaths, kerbs and gutters and traffic infrastructure is a key priority. Council is maintaining community assets to protect safety and accessibility for all and ensure the cost to ratepayers of any repair works is minimised through ongoing maintenance.

Council is investing approximately \$1.3 million to bring you this project.

These works are part of the \$33.2m investment Council has allocated to local roads, footpaths, traffic facilities, town centres, stormwater, car parks, town centres and cycleway upgrades this financial year.

Project features

The new concrete road slabs will be smoother, more durable and will improve road safety.

Timings and work hours

The works are scheduled to commence on **Norton Street** on **Monday night 23 January 2023** and will take approximately **10 nights** to complete, (weather permitting).

The works on **Marion Street** are scheduled to commence on **Monday night 30 January 2023** and will take approximately **4 nights** to complete, (weather permitting).

The works will take place between 7:30pm and 5:00am.

The scheduling of this work may change. You will receive a letter confirming the date 2-3 days before the work commences.

The works locations will need to be clear of parked cars during the working hours. Council's contractor will advise residents of specific locations affected as works progress.

Reducing construction impacts

The work will be completed each night in sections moving along the street.

Works that generate more noise such as saw cutting and jack hammering will be completed between 7:30pm and 11:30pm. Quieter work such as equipment set up and pack up, steel fixing and concrete pouring will follow between 11:30pm and 5:00am.

Traffic controllers will maintain safe access for residents during the works. Some minor inconvenience may be experienced.

The works locations will need to be clear of parked cars during the working hours. Council's contractor will advise residents of specific locations affected as works progress.
