Stephen Street, Balmain – Asphalt Footpath Renewal – both sides

Dear Resident,

Inner West Council will soon be renewing the asphalt footpath in Stephen Street, Balmain – both sides between Vincent St and Darling St.

Providing high quality footpaths, kerbs and gutters and traffic infrastructure is a key priority. Council is maintaining community assets to protect safety and accessibility for all and ensure the cost to ratepayers of any repair works is minimised through ongoing maintenance.

These works are part of the \$33.2m investment Council has allocated to local roads, footpaths, traffic facilities, town centres, stormwater, car parks, town centres and cycleway upgrades this financial year.

- Replacement of the stormwater lines from the property to kerb outlet
