Dear Resident,

Inner West Council will soon be upgrading the garden beds at Lackey Street, between Smith Street and Carton Crescent, Summer Hill as part of Public Domain Upgrade.

Providing high quality footpaths, kerbs and gutters and traffic infrastructure is a key priority. Council is maintaining community assets to protect safety and accessibility for all and ensure the cost to ratepayers of any repair works is minimised through ongoing maintenance.

Council is investing approximately \$32,300 to bring you this project.

These works are part of the \$33m investment Council has allocated to local roads, footpaths, traffic facilities, town centres, stormwater, car parks, town centres and cycleway upgrades this financial year.
