Stephen Street, Balmain (Vincent Street to End) – Parking Improvement Works Have Your Say

Council is planning to improve the existing parking arrangements in Stephen Street, Balmain (Vincent Street to End) by adjusting the existing kerb on the western side of the street to widen the road and forming indented parking bays. The proposed works is intended to improve pedestrian and motorist safety in the area.

The Plan

The following works are proposed and are illustrated on the attached plans Stephen Street, Balmain (Plan No. 10203):

- Remove existing kerb & gutter on the western side of the street and construct new kerb only along new alignment to form indented parking bays (from A to B) as shown on attached plans,
- Construct new dish drain along alignment of removed kerb & gutter (from A to B) as shown on attached plans,
- Reconstruct existing asphalt footpath with new asphalt footpath (western side adjacent to Birrung Park),
- Reconstruct some damaged sections of asphalt footpath with new asphalt footpath,
- · Resurface the road pavement in Stephen Street with new asphalt,
- Construct 4 new kerb ramps (where shown on the plans),
- Reconstruct some damaged sections of kerb & gutter with new concrete kerb & gutter,
- Upgrading existing stormwater drainage pits with new grates and inlet lintels,
- Reconstruct the entry driveway into Birrung Park,
- Install new No Stopping signs to ensure safe access, parking and manoeuvring into and out
 of Stephen Street, and
- Install associated pavement line marking and signage as required.

Parking changes:

The realignment of the kerb on the western side of Stephen Street will widen the road pavement which will better manage parking on this side of the street and eliminate the need to park vehicles partially onto the footpath.,

It is proposed to provide new "No Stopping" zones and signage to ensure minimum clearances are met for vehicle manoeuvring in the street and to better delineate areas available for parking. Accordingly, there will be NO LOSS of existing parking spaces in Stephen Street as a result of the proposed works. Please refer to the attached plans

Streetlighting

The existing lighting is deemed adequate and therefore there will be no changes to the existing street lighting due to the proposed works.

What happens next?

Council has not yet made any commitment to change the traffic and parking arrangements in the street. A report, together with the community's comments and this proposal, will be considered by Council's Local Traffic Committee at its meeting on Monday, 20 June 2022. The Committee will make recommendations for Council to consider at the Council meeting on Tuesday, 9 August 2022.

Council will notify everyone who provided comments of the final decision.

Members of the public may register to speak at this meeting. Please note that COVID restrictions may apply and limit personal attendance to the Traffic Committee (subject to restrictions in place).

When is the work planned?

These works are expected to be undertaken during the 2022/2023 financial year, subject to the outcome of this community engagement, final approvals, and budget allocations. No firm construction date is yet available, and residents will be notified further before any work starts in the street.
