1. Policy Challenge - How do we support a network of green habitat for plants, microforests, trees and animals when we have limited open space?	A policy challenge for this Local Democracy Group as resolved by Council at its meeting in October 2022 (C1022(1) Item 11) is: How do we support a network of green habitat for plants, microforests, trees and animals when we have limited open space? To commence addressing the policy question, the Environment Advisory Committee participated in a Walk and Talk of the Cooks River Foreshores led by Terry Lennis and Tealia Scott. The aim was to establish a shared understanding of current practices, challenges, and opportunities across the Local Government Area using the Cooks River parklands as a case study. Terry Lennis is a Darug and Darawahl man of the land and river, fellow committee member, and respected horticulturalist, who has led bush tucker programs across Sydney. Tealia Scott is Inner West Council's Coordinator Urban Ecology Volunteers and Projects. Tealia is a Sydney basin plant specialist with 20 years of experience in land conservation management.	Discussion in relation to baseline conditions, current practices and programs, challenges, and opportunities. Future committee meetings to build on and refine the committee's recommendations relating to the policy question back to Council.
