4. Business arising

Summary

8. Health and wellbeing talks – programming

The Not So Young Club has monthly talks that could be replicated. Libraries also have health and wellbeing talks.

In terms of priorities the working group listed the following ideas:

- Dementia
- Retirement villages understanding the fee scale and not get 'burnt'
- Euthanasia although a bit taboo
- Osteoarthritis and chronic disease management
- Falls prevention
- Types of affordable holidays
- Seniors discounts



Mary discussed the community development approach used in the team with a view to working more collaboratively and in partnership rather than Council managing facilitators directly.

Could gyms offer discount rates when not busy?. Be good to explore what other activities exist in the inner west.

Actions

- Mary to ask the Business Development staff if they can approach gyms
- Graham offered to ask in his neighbourhood what seniors activities may exist.

9. Intergenerational programs

The working Group joined the Young Leaders Working group to brainstorm some ideas for future collaboration.

Issues of mental health and lonliness were discussed. Also that the inner west has talent and cultural diversity across all age groups.

Ideas tabled were:

- Cooking
- Sharing old recipes
- Teaching westerners to make dumplings, rice paper rolls
- Outreach in Marrickville
- Street parties two way street
- Photobooth



- Something at the festival (Marrickville or Dulwich Hill Fair)
 - Making buntings and as people walk by they can write something on a bunting about how to address lonliness as an example
- Skate park an option of venue maybe a picnic
- 21st October Mental Health Month a date to work towards
