ITEM 3– Challenge questions (Update)

The two challenges allocated to the Transport Advisory Committee are:

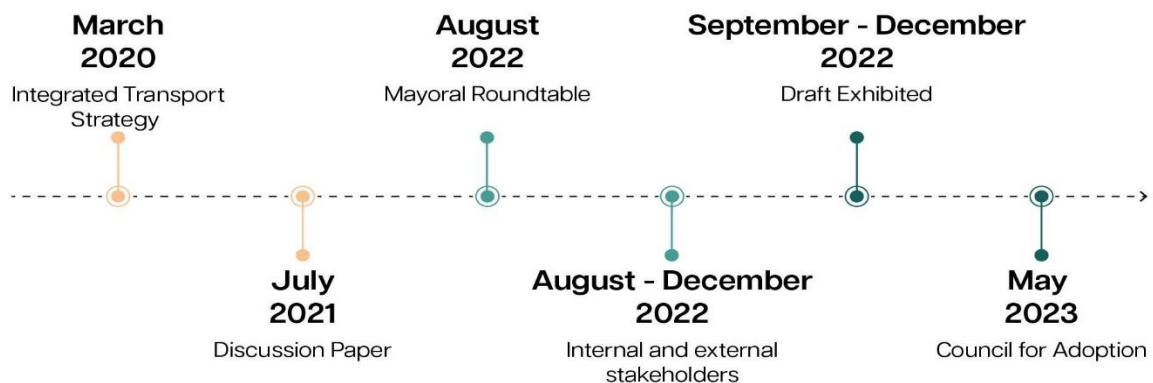
1. *How do we help to improve air quality and reduce road noise in the LGA by facilitating the uptake of electric vehicles and by other measures, including providing electric vehicle charging for residents who do not have off-street parking?*
2. *Should IWC adopt targets for the percentage of trips by active and public transport, and if so, what should these be?*

Committee Members are asked to provide feedback on how these challenges are progressing and any additional steps they would suggest to meet them.

ITEM 4 - Electric Vehicle Encouragement Strategy – Progress Report

Council's Electric Vehicle Encouragement Strategy and Action Plan (The Policy) was originally to be included in the Transport Technology Framework recommended in the Inner West Integrated Transport Strategy “*Going Places*” (2020). In recognition of the growing importance of electric vehicles it was decided that the electric vehicle component of the Transport Technology Framework would be progressed ahead of the overall framework. Policy development commenced with the distribution of a Discussion Paper to key stakeholders in July 2021.

Policy work progressed as indicated on the timeline below.



Subsequent to its exhibition at the end of 2022, with 123 submissions being received, the draft Policy has been revised and will be presented to Council in the near future.

The Strategy sets:

- A Goal;
- A Vision;
- Three Principles and
- Two Strategic Directions.

The Action Plan recommends a series of Actions prioritised as:

- Immediate
- Medium Term
- Longer Term
