# ITEM 3 - Draft Bike Strategy & Action Plan

The Inner West Bicycle Strategy & Action Plan was exhibited for public comment between 26 October 2022 and 28 November 2022.

Submissions are currently being reviewed and will inform finalisation of the Bicycle Strategy and development of its associated Action Plan.

Committee will be provided with and overview of the *Strategy & Action Plan's* current progress and given the opportunity to provide input into its next stage of development.

# **ITEM 4 - Rozelle Town Centre Master Plan**

Council's Public Domain Team have recently commenced the development of four Town Centre Master Plans.

The Master Plan Study Areas are:

- Rozelle (Victoria Road & part of Darling Street);
- Marrickville (Marrickville Road & Illawarra Road);
- Dulwich Hill (Marrickville Road & part of New Canterbury Road, as well as the "station precinct");
- Newtown (King Street & Enmore Road).

The first area being considered is Rozelle.

Our Public Domain Team have offered to discuss the Rozelle Master Plan Process with the Transport Advisory Committee to:

- Provide an overview of the Rozelle Town Centre Masterplan project and Councils' broader Streets Alive program;
- Capture the priorities of the Committee's focus;
- Raise awareness/promote among the networks of the individuals involved in the Committee Members:
- Invite the Committee (or its Members) to make a submission during the engagement period;
- Promote the survey and interactive map (opening until 27th February).

### ITEM 5 - General Business

#### 5.1 Leichhardt Oval Master Plan Process

Council is beginning work on a new Master Plan to upgrade and renovate facilities at Leichhardt Oval.

The Master Plan will seek to preserve and protect the heritage of the ground, including the Wayne Pearce Hill and Keith Barnes Stand, while providing the modern seating and facilities the ground desperately needs.

The Master Plan will set the vision, identify opportunities and develop a design blueprint for future improvements at Leichhardt Oval over the next ten years.

## Master Plan Scope

The Master Plan will consider the following items:

- Hosting a minimum of six Wests Tigers home games a year
- A major new grandstand providing modern seating for professional sport
- A Museum of Inner West Rugby League
- Modern amenities including new change rooms, toilets, food outlets and screens
- New function facilities
- Improved parking
- Opening the ground up to the public as a community centre during the week
- Concurrent upgrade of the adjoining Leichhardt Park Aquatic Centre providing improved gym, rehabilitation and aquatic facilities for users of Leichhardt Oval and the community

From 18 November - 18 December 2022 Council invited the community to be involved in the planning for Leichhardt Oval via an online survey and interactive mapping tool.

Three community drop-in sessions were held during the engagement period to allow community members to ask questions of the project team and share their ideas in person.

Council is now reviewing the feedback and will report back to the community with the Engagement Outcomes.
