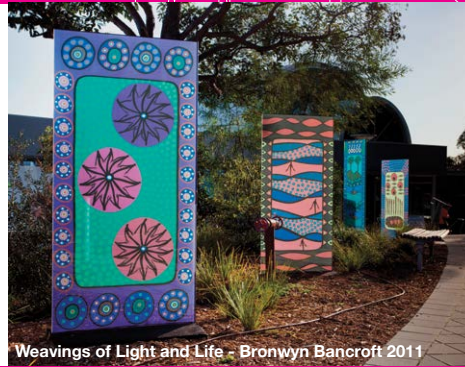

Bronwyn Gallery

Bronwyn Bancroft is a founding member of the Boomalli Aboriginal Artists Co-operative, which is one of Australia's oldest Indigenous-run artists' organisations, established in 1987. Boomalli is now located in Flood Street, Leichhardt.

Bronwyn served in the roles of chairperson, director, and treasurer during its first two decades, and is still actively involved in the organisation to this day. In 1985, Bronwyn opened a shop in Sydney called Designer Aboriginals, and in 1987 was one of the first Australian fashion designers invited to show work in Paris.

Two years later, in 1989, she contributed to a London exhibition, Australian Fashion: The Contemporary Art. In recent years Bronwyn is better known for her painting and is described as "an instinctive colourist."

In 2011 Leichhardt Council commissioned Bronwyn to complete her public artwork, *Weavings of Light and Life*, which stands outside of the Leichhardt Park Aquatic Centre (No. 17). Bronwyn used her skills as a colourist in this beautiful work, which is a series of seven glass panels reminiscent of stained glass. Each design was created in response to the local landscape and history of the original people who lived in the area. These works honour the past and show respect for the Custodians of the land.

Each of the seven panels has a theme:

- The Land and Foreshore
- Food collection
- Food collected by fishing with hand made hooks
- Song lines - being able to enter another Aboriginal groups' boundary
- Kinship - family law and connections
- A shield for protection of lands and family
- Water- the source of life as found in streams around the area.
