



Fresh seasonal produce box competition – Term and conditions

Conditions of entry

Entry is via subscription to Inner West Council's Enviro News newsletter and response to question.

One photo must be uploaded that is 3MB or less in size as a .jpeg file. The photo must be captioned using 50 words or less.

The photo must feature one or more plastic free, reusable item/s and one or more person/s taken within the boundaries of the Inner West Council LGA.

Eligibility

Entrants must be residents of the Inner West Council area.

Only one entry per person will be accepted.

Entrants under 18 years of age need to have the consent of their parent or guardian to enter. Any photo taken of a person/s under 18 years of age must have consent of their parent or guardian for that photo to be used as an entry to this competition.



Entry into the competition is free.

Winners will be chosen according to creativity as judged by the Inner West Council Resource Recovery Team from all entries received during the period of the competition. The judge's decision is final and cannot be contested.

Employees and immediate family members of employees of Inner West Council are ineligible to enter the promotion.

Promotional period

The promotion commences at 9am (AEDT) on 1 July 2022 and ends at 11:59pm (AEDT) on 31 August 2022 (Promotional Period). After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.

No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.

Prizes

One winner will be chosen during the week following the promotional period (total of one winner).

The prize can be collected from Petersham Customer Service Centre within three weeks of the competition closing. The prize
