A single storey residence with considerable character, designed carefully to address its corner site. It is virtually symmetrical about the diagonal axis drawn from the corner. This is emphasised by the gabled bay projecting into the angle of the verandah, which has two							
windows with moulded brick reveals and buillnose sills. The corners of the bay are also bullnosed. The walling of red brick is							
emphasised by a band of liver bricks at sill level, by an entrance arch and by a bullseye window beside the entrance. Other detailing is as							
expected in a Queen Anne design, including roughcast gable panels and convex chimney friezes, vermiculated panels, encaustic							
verandah floor; but it is generally of very high standard, especially the verandah decoration of turned and fretted timber.							
MODIFICATION:							
Very intact externally but rendered somewhat forbidding by an unimaginative paint treatment.
