	Its timber posts, which stand on stone bases, are square, unevenly spaced, and the embellishment is fretworked, not turned. The main					
roof ridge runs parallel with the street and has a louvred gablet at each end. There are two fine bay windows, one at the front						
and one at the side, having sandstone bases. A pair of French doors open from the verandah. The chimneys are of stucco lined to simulate						
ashlar, and have two layers of mouldings and grey terra cotta chinaman cowl pots. The entrance steps have treads of marble and						
risers of narrow green glazed ceramic tiles.
