DESCRIPTION:						
The house has a main gable with its ridge parallel to the street. From this an asymmetrically placed subsidiary gable projects towards						
the field. A filled gable projects to the side. The gables have exposed purlins, roughcast and cover strapped walls and exert and						
infed with boarding. A liat-rooted faceted window bay has sandstone quoins and exposed rafters. Above the entrance there is a first						
lead ballothy with a shinigled ballustrade, aproned as a fascia standing proud of the brickwork. Above this is a comistrouler standing proud of the brickwork.						
The halfe Edgarrio is incorporated in the leaded glass of the front door, which also has sidelights. The chimneys are finished with						
roughcast with brick tops and terra cotta pots.
