	gablets. The central entrance door has nine panels and sideligh						
gable, a window bay having casements with small coloured bottom panes, and barge boards with decorated ends. Each gable has							
apex infill of vertical members and pressed metal in fish scale pattern. The verandah roof sweeps down from the main slope and extends							
across the face of each side bay as a skillion. It is supported on four turned timber posts with arched valance motifs between. The							
verandah floor is tiled with a white marble nosed edging. The front fence is of timber pickets swept up to posts.							
MODIFICATION:							
The roof covering appears to be a sympathetic replacement.							
Two chimneys have been cut off at the eaves.
