A simple, reserved and well detailed design of considerable quality. The centre porch is supported on square brick piers treated as panelled						
pilasters with moulded render capitals. The windows on each side are two light, double hung and shuttered, with soldier course lintels and						
squinch sills. The top sashes are divided into 6 panes. The doorcase, under a semi elliptical arch, has leaded glass sidelights, a						
fanlight, and a front door with a glazed top panel in six panes. The porch has a tesselated tile floor and terrazzo sill. It is approached by a						
curved path leading from the fence, which has piers with header brick soldier course caps and panels with chamfer-brick copings. There is a						
pleasant, small front garden.
