History of the Item

Number 41 was named "Frieccourt" and was extant by 1922. Its twin No 39 was built shortly afterwards and was extant by 1925 when it was named "Merville".

Physical Description

Single storey semi-detached pair of cottages showing Californian Bungalow influence. Built of dark face brick. Prominent overarching gable with smaller gable in front. Roofed with Marseilles terra cotta tiles. Gable ends are clad with fibro with vertical timber cover strips. Both gables have grilled ventilators, of different pattern. Both cottages had porches roofed with flat roofs clad with metal roofing which were supported by tapering massive brick piers with rough cast render. These have both been enclosed with aluminium windows. Front fence are of same dark brick with pipe rails.
