DESCRIPTIO							
A single storey house of traditional asymmetrical design, having a parapetted window bay in its side gable wing and a verandah ensemble							
of paired cast iron posts and decoration, the posts having wreathed foliated shafts. The house has a number of unusual features: some							
stucco quoining; decorative slate patterning; a large gabled attached wing at the rear; and a distinctive iron palisade fence with picket							
spears arranged in a wave design, including the gate. The gate posts are of cast iron, in the form of composite columns surmounted							
by balls.							
MODIFICATION:							
Part of verandah enclosed. Chimney cornices simplified. Bases of gate posts altered. Part of fence removed for driveway.
