History of the Item

This land was originally owned by Richard Stanton, developer of Haberfield. The land was transferred to Walter W Anderson, a commercial traveller in 1911 for £150. Anderson then built these dwellings. They were first listed in Sands Directory in 1912.

Physical Description

Federation/Queen Anne style single storey semi-detached residences. Polychrome face brick construction with upper parts of walls clad with rough cast render. Hipped roof clad with Marseilles terra cotta tile roof with decorated ridge capping. Side entrances. Simple timber decoration around verandah and side entrance. Tall rendered chimneys with decorative brick. Small gablet faces west towards Ashfield Park. Triple casement windows with coloured fanlights. A new fence of squared pickets is front of both Nos 51 and 53.
