Camphor Laurel, Kaffir Plum, Lilly Pilly, Cabbage Palm, Araucaria, Chinese Elm and Liquidambar.							
The house is asymmetrical in design, with rusticated classical portico facing the street and a long verandah on the north-east side. The							
ground floor verandah has columns and a deep frieze of cast iron, while the first floor verandah has timber posts, fretwork balustrades							
and arched valances. One verandah bay has timber louvre infill. The ample roof eaves are boxed with boarding.
