

A simple, narrow house of terrace form, having a short ridge parallel to the street, parapetted side gables and firewalls undecorated except					
for consoles supporting the lower eaves stop. The decorative verandah cast iron comprises fringe, frieze and bracket at lower level					
and balustrade only above. The front door has rounded top panels and the upper balcony is accessed by french doors.					
The front fence is of pickets. There are mature Jacarandas in the front garden.
