History of the Item

This land was subdivided in 1937.

Physical Description

Two storey brick block of flats with some elements of Inter war Art Deco style. A hipped roof clad with Marseilles terra cotta tiles covers the building. The walls are of dark brown face bricks with lighter brown texture bricks used for contrast around the entrance doorway, as soldier courses above windows and as vertical panels on the facade. The side walls are built of lighter common bricks. The stairwell window features a star burst pattern in the glazing bars. Glass doors with glass sidelights lead into recessed porches on the front flats. Two of these have been enclosed. Double hung sash windows are used around the building. A low fence with short piers built of bricks identical to the building is at the front.
