Physical Description

Single storey brick cottage Queen Anne/Federation in style. Hipped roof clad with slate with terra cotta ridge capping. Twin chimneys clad with rough cast render with brick dentils and banding with terra cotta pots. The front verandah is supported by triple squared timber posts with timber infill and large curved timber brackets. Windows are triple casements with coloured glass panes at the bottom. The front fence is of rendered masonry and is not original. The front garden is screened from the street by a high hedge. A tall auracaria in the front yard may be a remnant of an earlier garden.
