\$5.2 million upgrade to the Bay Run

Dear resident,

I'm writing to let you know that we are upgrading the **Bay Run path, lighting and the Lilyfield Road bridge** as part of the Cooks to Cove GreenWay Master Plan.

When completed in 2024, the GreenWay will connect the whole Inner West, from the Cooks River to Iron Cove, with a pedestrian, cycling and biodiversity corridor. We are completing this project in stages and delivering beautiful parks and natural areas, sporting facilities and public artworks along the corridor.

We are investing \$5.2 million to undertake this section of the GreenWay, which includes:

- Upgrades to the path, lighting and landscaping along the Bay Run between
 UTS Haberfield Rowers Club and Lilyfield Road and from the Bay Run into Richard
 Murden Reserve
- Upgrades to the lighting through Leichhardt Park
- New line markings along Mortley Avenue
- A new path through Robson Park and crossing point at Boomerang Street
- A temporary shared path along Dobroyd Parade and Hawthorne Parade during the works

The Bay Run is one of Sydney's most popular walking, running and cycling routes. These improvements will provide a safer and more enjoyable experience for all users of the Bay Run. **Please** see the reverse side for more details including the schedule of works and access changes.

Upgrading the Bay Run

Timings and work hours

Works are planned to commence on 2 May 2022 and will be completed in stages:

- May 2022: works in Robson Park, Mortley Ave, Boomerang Street, Dobroyd Parade and Hawthorne Parade and outside UTS Haberfield Rowers Club
- June to September 2022: upgrades between UTS Haberfield Rowers Club and Lilyfield Road bridge, and new lighting through Leichhardt Park
- August 2022 to January 2023: upgrades on Lilyfield Road bridge and Lilyfield

Work will take place during standard working hours (7am – 5pm) on weekdays. Some night and/or weekend works may be required to deliver materials from the City West link to the Bay Run.

Access changes during works

From June to August 2022 the Bay Run will be closed between UTS Haberfield Rowers Club, Lilyfield Road and Richard Murden Reserve to facilitate construction works.

An alternate route will be provided for pedestrians and cyclists through Robson Park and along Dobroyd and Hawthorne Parades. Pedestrian and traffic control measures will be in place for the duration of the works.
