

GreenWay Night Works

Longport Street Lewisham, 27 – 31 May 2024

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. As part of the next phase of GreenWay construction, watermain modification and valve installation works on Longport Street bridge, are required.

Where will the work be undertaken?

Construction night work will be undertaken on the footpath on the northern side of Longport Street bridge. The footpath in this location will be closed and a detour will be in place for pedestrians. Roads will not be affected during the works.

What type of work is being done?

Adjustments will need to be made to the watermain on Longport Street bridge. These works include excavation with a small excavator, pipe cutting and repair, concrete works and pavement restoration.

When will the work be undertaken?

The night work will take place over five nights from Monday 27 May to Friday 31 May, 7pm to 5am (weather permitting). These works can only take place during these hours due to the limited path closure hours during the day and also to reduce the impact to pedestrians.

What will be done to minimise inconvenience for me?

Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with the works. The excavator is the minimum size required for this excavation work and traffic control will be implemented.
