

## **Fencing Night Works Confirmed 9–10 October 2023**

As the next phase of the GreenWay construction, permanent fencing has been installed in the light rail corridor near Lewisham West. The temporary fencing will be removed.

### **Where will the work be undertaken?**

Construction night work will be undertaken inside the light rail corridor near Lewisham West light rail station between Longport Street and Old Canterbury Road.

### **What type of work is being done?**

A permanent fence, separating the light rail from the GreenWay construction area has been constructed, and the temporary construction site fencing will be removed, as announced in the previous construction notice.

### **When will the work be undertaken?**

The night work will take place on Monday 9 October, with Tuesday 10 October as a contingency, from about 11pm to 6am. The temporary fencing can only be safely removed at night when there is no light rail train movement.

### **What will be done to minimise inconvenience for me?**

Every effort will be made to minimise noise. The fencing will be removed by hand, with minimal use of low noise power tools.
