GreenWay construction notice

Nightworks near Arlington Light Rail Station, Dulwich Hill

Midnight to 5am, Tuesday 15 July 2025

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. As part of the GreenWay construction, we are relocating some sections of drainage from within the light rail corridor near Arlington light rail station.

Where will the construction take place?

Construction will take place inside the light rail corridor just north of Constitution Road bridge, near Arlington light rail station in Dulwich Hill

What type of work is being done?

We are relocating some sections of drainage from inside the light rail corridor to within the GreenWay boundary.

When will these works take place?

Night works are scheduled for the early hours of Tuesday 15 July during light rail closure times, between midnight and 5am, weather permitting. Works are expected to take one night to complete.

As a contingency, works could extend for a second night: the early hours of Wednesday 16 July from midnight to 5am.

What will be done to minimise inconvenience to me?

A light tower will be used to carry out these works safely. There will be some noise associated with these works, however every effort will be made to minimise impacts to residents within the area.

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works.
