GreenWay weekend works

Arlington to Dulwich Grove light rail stations

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. As part of the GreenWay works, weekend construction has been scheduled to coincide with the planned closure of the Inner West light rail line.

Where will these works take place?

The works will be undertaken along the western side of the light rail corridor between Arlington and Dulwich Grove light rail stations in Dulwich Hill. The adjacent roads and light rail will be used to provide access to the works area.

What type of work is being done?

Minor earthworks and fencing upgrades are taking place, that can only be safely completed during a full closure of the light rail.

When will these works take place?

The works are scheduled to take place during the planned light rail shutdown on Saturday 6 September and Sunday 7 September 2025.

Works hours: 6am - 7pm.

Minimising work impacts to local residents

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works.

Other agencies may also be undertaking works during this planned light rail shutdown and will provide their own notification.
